The ideal district population, **39,202**, is based on the 2020 Census.
HD 19 has **38,433** people, which is **-1.96%** from the ideal.
16.55% of the people in the district are new constituents.

- 25.7% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.54% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 6.34% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.12% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 64.15% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 3.11% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 4.4% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

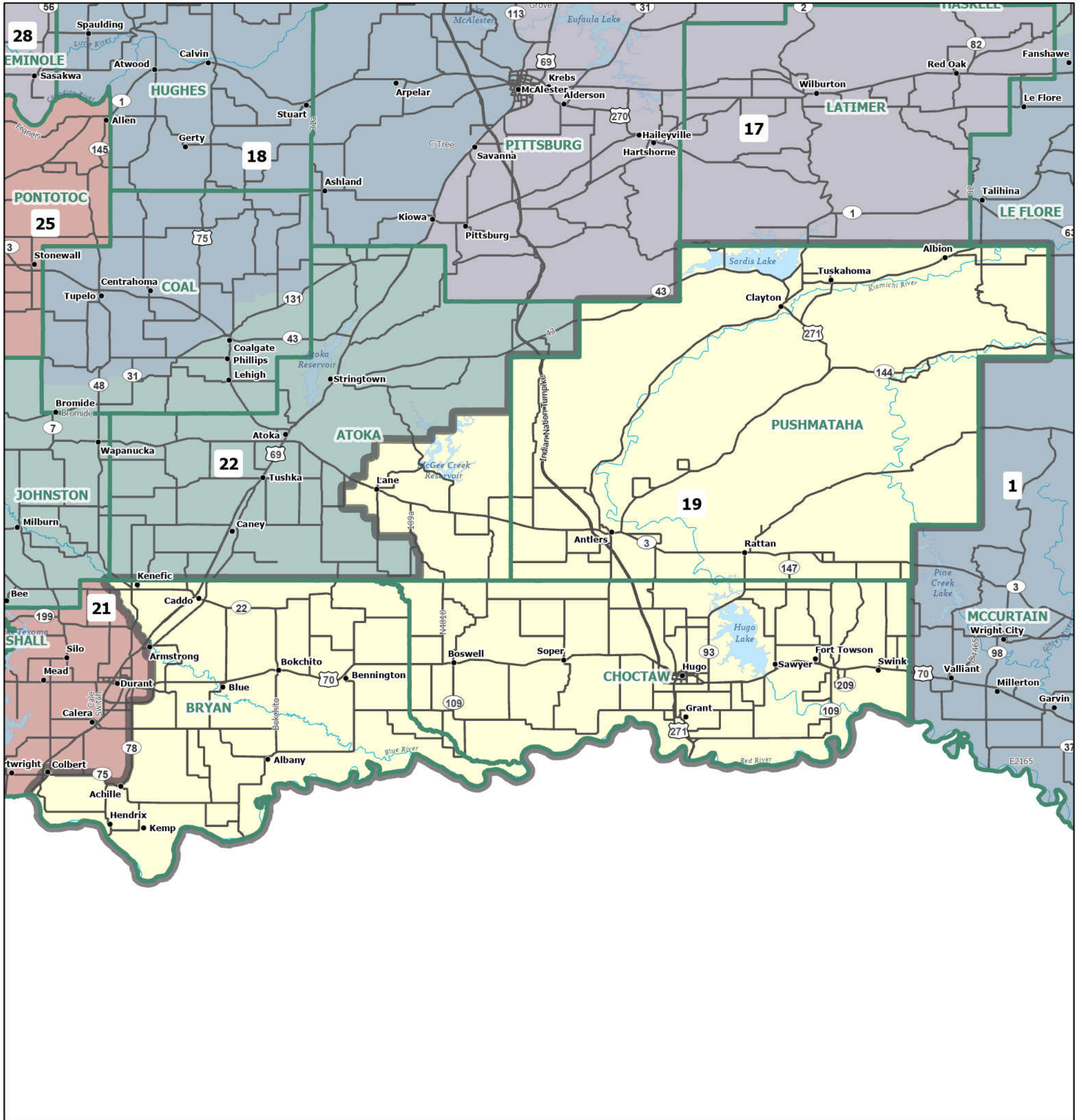

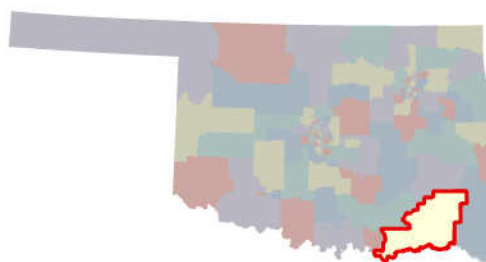
