

# House District 29 | 2022–2031

The ideal district population, **39,202**, is based on the 2020 Census.  
**HD 29** has **39,200** people, which is **-0.01%** from the ideal.  
**18.39%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

19.75% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.  
 0.86% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.  
 3.69% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.  
 0.18% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.  
 72.42% of the district is non-Hispanic white.  
 2.98% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.  
 4.05% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

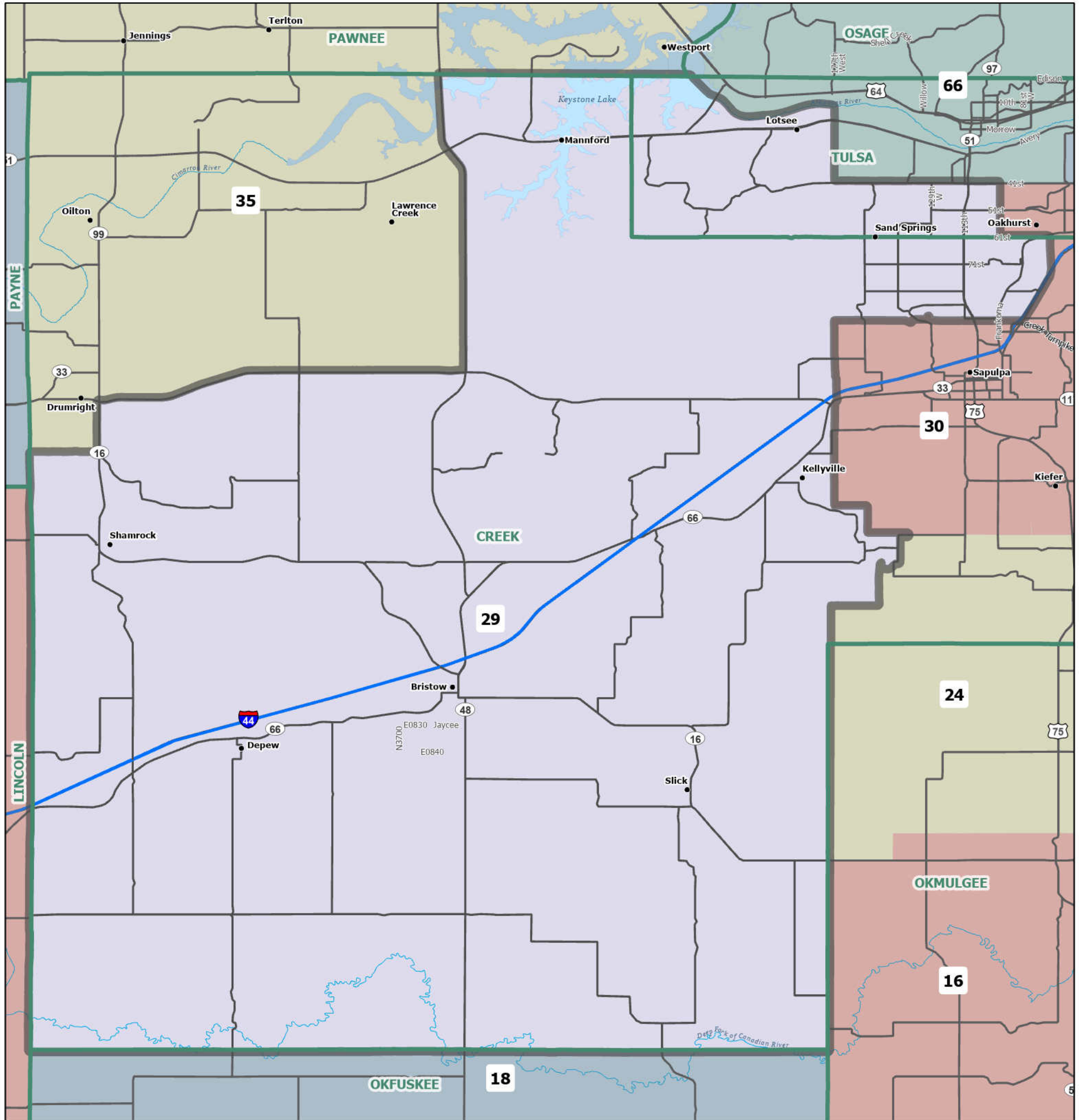

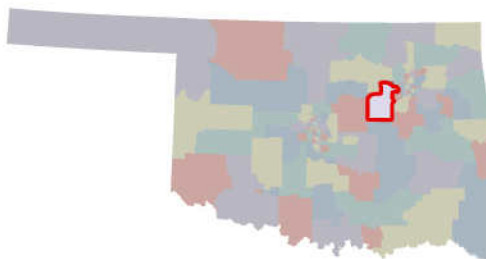
